Calvin Jones BIG BAND Jazz Festival Celebrates 32 Years of World Class Jazz at the University of the District of Columbia

Washington, D.C. – On Monday, April 27, 2020 at 8:00 PM, the BIG BAND sound returns to the University of the District of Columbia for the 34th year at the **Calvin Jones BIG BAND Jazz Festival**. Once again, the powerhouse jazz ensembles from the University of the District of Columbia (directed by Allyn Johnson), Howard University (directed by Fred Irby III), and the University of Maryland (directed by Tim Powell) will cap-off *Jazz Appreciation Month* with a hand-clapping, finger-snapping, foot-stomping good time.

Produced by the University of the District of Columbia Jazz Studies Program and the Felix E. Grant Jazz Archives, the festival began in 1987 as part of a citywide tribute to Duke Ellington and remains one of the most anticipated events on Washington, D.C.'s jazz calendar.
